### **CELEBRATING CANADIAN WOMEN:**

- Continuing our week-long celebration of Canadian Women in honour of International Women's day, Today we celebrate Dr. Roberta Bondar: Bondar was born in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, on December 4, 1945. Bondar became Canada's first female astronaut and the first neurologist in space when she flew on the NASA Space Shuttle Discovery during Mission STS-42, from January 22–30. Her work studying the effects of low-gravity situations on the human body allowed NASA to prepare astronauts for long stays in the space station. Bondar has received many honours including appointment as a Companion of the Order of Canada, the NASA Space Medal, induction into the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame, and the International Women's Forum Hall of Fame.
