## Course Selection for the 2021-2022 School Year

Between February 18<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> students will be brought into the computer lab to complete their courses selection online. A virtual **Course Planning Information Evening for current Grade 8-11 students and families** is scheduled for February 25. Zoom invites will be emailed to families early next week.

## COVID Health and Safety
