Health and Safety:

While we are just over two weeks away from the start of Spring Break, it remains critical that each of us follows the health and safety guidelines from the Ministry. Please view the [letter](#) from Superintendent, Doug Sheppard, that includes some current health and safety information. Recently the Ministry provided some updated requirements for all students and staff. This includes wearing masks in all indoor areas, including when they are in learning groups.

The exceptions are when:

- Students are sitting or standing at their seat or work station in a classroom.
- Students are eating or drinking.
- There is a barrier in place.

We continue to encourage the following practices with all students:

- Wear masks all the time except when seated in your classroom at your seat, when eating/drinking or when a barrier is present. At all other times students must wear masks
- disperse in a timely manner at the end of the school day
- maintain physical distancing and wear masks outside the school prior to and after classes
- wash re-wearable masks daily after they have been worn
- keep at least 2 meters/6 feet from people outside of your cohort
- regularly wash/sanitize your hands
- sneeze and cough into the crease of your elbow
- refrain from gathering with people who are outside of your immediate household
- complete the [Daily Health Check](#)
- **remain at home when feeling ill or showing symptoms of illness**
