Quarter 3 Mid-Term Report Cards

Quarter 3 mid-term report cards were released today. Marks are viewable on students MyEd, parent and student connect. Please be aware that some staff members may use the following on this report card:

NM (No Mark)- Used in courses where teachers are doing performance indicators and have provided students with a mastery report describing their progress through the first half of the quarter. Please ask your child for a copy of the mastery report. Students will receive a final percentage at the end of Quarter 3.

I (In-Progress)- Used where students may currently not be meeting the learning outcomes in a course or where teachers do not have enough assessment completed to provide an accurate reflection of student progress. In many cases the narrative comment will provide a percentage that the student is currently working at.

School Hours Over the Break

Maintenance and custodial staff will be on site from March 15th-26th from 7:30am-4:00pm. The school office will be closed on March 22nd and 26th. The doors to the school will be locked so if any person requires access to the building you will have to call the number posted on the front door.
