Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope our families are well. This letter contains some important information as we approach the end of our third quarter.

Health and Safety Protocols:

The number of positive cases of COVID-19 continues to be larger than anyone would like. What is perhaps the most worrisome is the number of cases involving variants. I cannot stress enough that we ALL need to follow the protocols set out by the Provincial Health Officer, both at school and in the community. Yes, vaccines are coming but we need to be diligent while we are all waiting for our two shots.

Please continue to adhere to all Health and Safety Protocols:

- wear a face covering at all times when indoors
- disperse in a timely manner at the end of the school day
- maintain physical distancing and wear masks outside the school prior to and after classes
- wash re-wearable masks daily after they have been worn
- keep at least 2 meters/6 feet from people outside of your cohort
- regularly wash/sanitize your hands
- sneeze and cough into the crease of your elbow
- refrain from gathering with people who are outside of your immediate household
- complete the Daily Health Check
- remain at home when feeling ill or showing symptoms of illness

Quarter 4 Transition:

Reminder that the final day for Quarter 3 classes will be Wednesday, April 21st, with April 22nd scheduled as a 'Transition Day'. The 'Transition' Day will be used by staff to allow students to complete missing assessments prior to the end of quarter 3 and prepare for our fourth quarter. Many classes on the transition day will be optional for students to attend but will be at the discretion of the classroom teacher.

Students' complete timetables are viewable on MyED and Student Connect. Students must check their Quarter 4 classes so they know where they will be attending on April 23rd to start Quarter 4. If any student is requesting a Quarter 4 course change, they must complete the Course Change form available on the Delview website and not attend the class until they have received communication back from their counsellor. We are going to be very limited in the number of changes that we can make to a student's schedule due to learning group restrictions and timetable limitations.

Quarter 4 Hybrid Classes

In quarter 4 majority of Grade 10, 11 and 12 B block classes and all multi-grade (9-12) classes will be run as hybrid, at 50% density. If classes have 15 students or less they will not be run as a hybrid. Hybrid teachers have two options to run their hybrid courses based on the needs of the course, students and maximizing face to face time in our academic subjects. Please note the two options for hybrid teachers are:

Option 1- Divide your class in half and students attend every second day with an aspect of remote learning

Prior to the start of the fourth quarter, students and their families should receive an email from their quarter 4 teachers indicating which option they have chosen, and which group students have been assigned. If you have any questions, please reach out to the classroom teacher by email.
