volunteer. This year Delview students will continue with our traditional door to door collection as well as maintaining the drive thru donation option started during Covid.




Delview Athletics

Semester 1 Interim Reports

Interims will only be completed for students that are currently below 60% or those that have not engaged through the start of the first semester. Interims are meant to communicate concerns while providing sufficient time for students to turn things around prior to the release of Mid-Term report cards.

Parent Teacher Interviews-October 24th

On Tuesday, October 24th Delview will be welcoming families into the school for in-person Parent Teacher Interviews. Parents will be able to sign-up to see their child's teachers using Parent Connect. The sign-up system will be open on **October 17th** and will remain open until the morning of October 23rd. Flex Time

Flex time will be used as instructional time to provide additional support for students within their classes. As flex time is instructional time, attendance in flex is mandatory and staff will be taking attendance every day.

During the second week of school we ran assemblies for all Grade 8 students and students in grades 9-12 new to Delview. Students are encouraged to be pro-active by registering ahead of time with one of their current teachers, or in the library or gym which is open to all students. Flex is about students taking responsibility for their own learning, recognizing where they need to be and prioritizing spaces that provide the educational supports needed to assist their learning. Families are reminded and encouraged to track your student's flex choices within Parent Connect and have conversations at home to assist in their planning.

Innovation 10 Field Trip

This week, Delview's Innovation 10 class took a field trip to Deas Island and the Gulf of Georgia Cannery in Richmond.



The trip was focused around the Japanese community in B.C. and the injustice of Internment Camps during WWII.

MYED and Student Connect Access

All students should now have signed onto their MYED accounts. Students who have a 'disabled' account can come down to the office for assistance.

Graduation Requirements
