All courses will be selected through the MyEd BC portal. Please use this sheet to help you plan your courses for next year. Effective the 2023/24 school year, all students working toward a B.C. Certificate of Graduation (“Dogwood Diploma”), must successfully complete at least 4 credits in Indigenous-focused coursework (English First Peoples 10, BC First Peoples 12, or English First Peoples 12).

Grade 10’s will have the following two major decisions to make:

1. Decide whether to take the Standard Program or the Innovation Program.
2. Select between two Math courses.

Students entering Grade 10 must:

1. Select a program:
 - a. Standard Program: Continue to use this worksheet.
 - b. Innovation Program: Stop and use the QR code to register.
2. Select all the following:
 - a. English 10 OR English First Peoples 10 (*EFP 10 fulfills the Indigenous course requirement for graduation*)
 - b. Social Studies 10
 - c. Science 10
 - d. Physical & Health Education 10 OR Physical & Health Education Leadership (application)
3. Must select one Math course:
 - a. Foundations & Pre-Calculus 10
 - b. Workplace Math 10
4. Select three electives: (listed on the back of this sheet)
