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




MINIMUM 80 CREDITS (grades 10 - 12)

Average student graduates with 96 - 100 credits (some up to 120)

\*each course = 4 credits... so = 20 courses minimum\*





- Literary Studies & Composition 10
- Acts a preview to Grade11 English courses

#### **English First Peoples 10**

- Fulfills the Indigenousfocused requirement for graduation
- Explores English First Peoples literature

#### **Social Studies track**

SS10 & a SS11 or 12 are graduation requirements




Psychology 11 \* Psychology 12 \*

Psychology counts as an elective and does not meet the grad requirement for SS11 or SS12

#### Math track Gr.9

A Math 10 and 11 are graduation requirements

Workplace = Entry into the majority of trades or direct entry to the workplace



Foundations= post-secondary programs not requiring theoretical calculus (i.e. most Arts programs)

Pre-Calculus= postsecondary programs requiring theoretical science

Ask your Math 9 teacher which math 10 they recommend!


#### Foundations & Pre-Calculus Math 10

- Leads to Foundations 11/12 or Pre-calculus 11/12

## Physical Health Education 10 Options

#### **PHE 10**

- Emphasis on active participation in variety of games, sports, and fitness activities
- Learning about wellbeing (i.e. physical, mental, socialemotional)

#### PHE 9/10 Leadership

- Focus on becoming leaders through use of recreation and classwork
- ½ PHE and ½ Leadership course
- Service hours mandatory
- Must apply on basis of leadership (i.e. skills, attitude, participation)

## Physical Health Education 10 Options

Volleyball & Fitness Concepts (10-12)

- On-court & physical training
- Counts as your PHE 10 credit
- For recreational and competitive volleyball players

Basketball & Fitness Concepts (10-12)

- On-court & physical training
- Focuses on developing basketball knowledge, skills, and abilities
- Counts as your PHE 10 credit
- For recreational and competitive basketball players

## Do I Need a 2<sup>nd</sup> Language?

You do *NOT* need a 2nd language to graduate OR to enter UBC or SFU effective 2026.

# Things to consider about a 2nd language:

- Post-secondary institutions may still consider a language as a course used to calculate GPA
- Opens doors to career opportunities!


