Delview Secondary School Grade 12 Course Selection Sheet

Information about graduation requirements and all of the courses offered at Delview can be found in the Course Planning Guide on the school website (“Course Planning” tab).

To meet graduation requirements, students must complete a minimum of 80 credits. The following criteria must be met:

- At least 16 credits are Grade 12 level (4 courses)
- 52 credits are Required Courses
- 28 credits are for Elective Courses (which must include a Fine Arts or ADST course)
- 4 credits are for Capstone & Career Life Connections 12
- Effective the 2023/24 school year, all students working toward a B.C. Certificate of Graduation (“Dogwood Diploma”), must successfully complete at least 4 credits in Indigenous-focused coursework which could be in English First Peoples 10, BC First Peoples 12, or English First Peoples 12, (most students will have this completed by grade 12, but if not, be sure to connect with your counselor).

All courses will be selected through the MyEd BC portal. Please use this sheet to help you plan your courses for next year.

Number of courses:

- Students entering Grade 12 must take 8 courses in their schedule; one of the 8 courses will be Career Life Education
- Students can take a 9th course outside of regular school hours.
- Students wishing to take a Study Block must have enough credits to graduate and select it (this would be one of your 6 courses)
